<p>Program Plan - Psychology</p>	<p>Student and Faculty enrichment</p>	<p>Improvement of classroom technology in HSS Building</p>	<p>Provide student and faculty enrichment opportunities</p>	<p>At a Psychology Department meeting, the Psychologists generated common issues that they encounter when dealing with the technology in the HSS Building: 1) Wiring issues between LCD projector and computers 2) audio issues (speakers often do not work) 3) inconsistent wireless connection (even hardwired computers do not get internet consistently 5) inconsistency of technology systems from room-to-room</p> <p>The issues with technology in the classrooms undermines student learning and is therefore detrimental to student success. When the instruction technology doesn't work, instructors must devote class time to rectifying the situation rather than covering course content. When the instructional technology stops working in the middle of a lecture, there is often a break in student concentration.
