Opticians are professionals who design and fit eyeglasses, contact lenses and other optical devices. They determine the best way to fill a client's prescription by:

Students must complete the prerequisites, core optical technology, and general education courses to earn the AS degree.

Students who complete the Optical Technology program will have the essential knowledge and skills to fabricate, fit, and dispense eyeglasses and contact lenses in manufacturing, retail, and professional vision care settings.
