AA Degree in General Studies – Pattern II or III

(for students with catalog rights of Fall 2008 or thereafter)

Pattern II – is for students who are planning to transfer to a four-year university in high-unit majors or where completion of CSU GE or IGETC is not appropriate or advisable.

Pattern III - is designed for students who are planning to transfer to a California four-year university (UC or CSU) and plan to use the CSU GE or IGETC pattern to fulfill their lower division general education requirements.

NOTE: Transfer requirements vary depending on major and transfer institution selected. Consult with the intended transfer institution, a Moorpark College counselor, and www.assist.org (for UC/CSU) for admission, general education, and major requirements
