NOTES

1. Completion of the IGETC satisfies all lower division general education requirements at most CSU and UC campuses, and some Independent Colleges and Universities. It is not an admission requirement nor is it the only way to fulfill lower division general education requirements.
2. IGETC may not be the best option for transfer with majors in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (STEM). IGETC for STEM may be an option, see a counselor for more information.
3. Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) to CSU: Although it is possible to fulfill the requirements for an ADT by completing the IGETC for UC pattern, students obtaining an ADT without the completion of Oral Communication (IGETC Area 1C) will not meet the CSU admissions requirements.
4. A course must have a minimum unit value of 3 semester or 4 quarter units and must be completed with a "C" or better, or Pass/Credit. A "C" is defined as a minimum 2.0 grade points on a 4.0 scale. A grade of "C-" is not acceptable. The UC system allows a maximum of 14 semester units graded "Pass/No-Pass".
5. **Full IGETC certification** requires the completion of ALL Areas (including Area 6 LOTE).
6. **Partial IGETC certification** requires the completion of all but two (2) courses on the IGETC pattern. Partial IGETC certification that does not include completion of Areas 1 and/or 2 may make a student ineligible for meeting the minimum admissions transfer requirements for CSU and/or UC.
