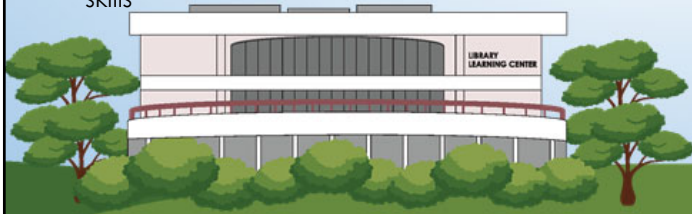
# LIBRARY

  - Wellness
  - Student Parents

## STUDENT HEALTH CENTER



- Located in the Administration building
- In-person and tele-health care (Phone/Zoom) available for enrolled students.

### Medical Care

- Medical care by physician/nurse practitioners/nurses for care of acute illnesses and injuries, program physicals, immunizations, and lab work.
- Offers Family Pact Services providing free sexually transmitted infection testing and treatment, birth control options, exams, and education.

### Mental Health Counseling

- A team comprised of a Psychologist, Marriage Family Therapist, and trainees provides mental Health Counseling.
- 6 Free mental health counseling appointments available each semester

### Health & Wellness Resources

- Mindfulness Training – learn to develop greater mental attention, focus, concentration and emotional balance.
- Find resources for food and homelessness, as well as other health and wellness resources.

### Welcome Center

- Located in the lobby of 1st floor
- Open Monday-Friday
- Welcome Center assists with:
  - Finding class schedules and course offerings
  - Registration Support, Adding/Dropping Courses
  - Answering general questions and providing information about programs, majors and student services
  - Student ID Card Services

### Student Business Office

Located on 1st floor

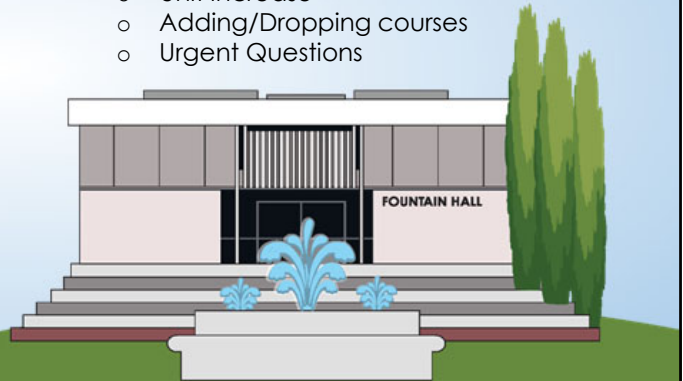
## Academic Counseling
